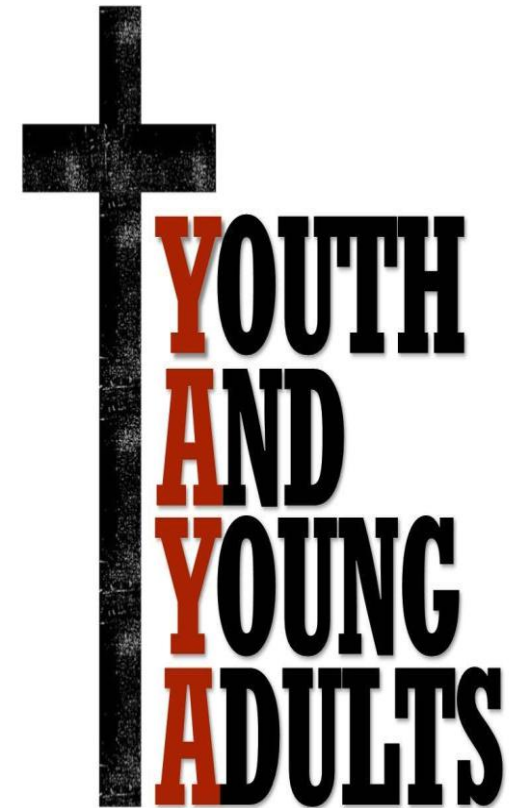

PARISH EVENTS

Youth Mass

The Youth Mass in our parish is held once a month on the 2nd Sunday of the month, starting at 6:15pm. It is celebrated at St Bernard's Church and is followed by a time of fellowship with free food in the church courtyard. We are always



looking for young people who want to be more involved in the church and use their talents and gifts in a number of roles. Some ministries during Mass are Welcoming, Altar Servers, Ministers of the Word (Readers), Prayers of Intercession and Ministers of Communion. Other roles include Announcements, Singers, Musicians, Sound Engineers, Mass co-ordinators, Procession of Gifts, Collections, Social and Media, or help with the environment of the church. If you feel like you need to step up into a role like this, get in touch with your Youth Minister. We find that our youth grow when they use their gifts and talents and discover more gifts within themselves. We are constantly creating opportunities for our youth, supporting, challenging and training them to look beyond themselves.

Youth Group

Gatherings are held once a month on a Friday night, from 7:00-9:00pm. This group is for youth from around ages 11 to 25. We have free food, lots of games organised and conducted by the youth, and opportunities for all to display their talents in a supportive environment. It is a great time for young people to connect on a new level, learn more about themselves and their faith and have some fun!



Youth Socials

Every so often, exciting social events are organised for the young people of the parish, from bowling outings, to trivia nights, to BBQs and touch footy in the park. Keep your eyes and ears open for notices of these in the Youth News or parish bulletin.
