WHAT IS THE PARISH HOSPITALITY TEAM?

‘The word **Hospitality** in the New Testament comes from two Greek words: the first word means ‘love’ and the second word means ‘strangers’. It’s a word that means love of strangers. Often we are strangers to each other. Often people come to our community from near and far. We are called to be welcoming and inclusive of others.

HOSPITALITY AND CATERING

Hospitality volunteers assist with serving at and /or catering for parish functions and welcoming new parishioners.

This involves:

- ♥ Planning and organising the hospitality and catering for whole Parish functions
- ♥ Collaborates with small community hospitality groups at each of the churches
- ♥ Organise and Provide Supper after Confirmation at St Bernard’s and St Catherine’s
- ♥ Assists in annual roster for Monthly morning tea after Mass



- ♥ Advertise and invite through each Mass a special Welcome to Uni Students each semester
- ♥ Collaborates with Liturgy Team and small community hospitality groups at each of the churches to celebrate Multicultural Weekend
